Memo of Sires

FARRER 220103: Used by A.I. for the 2024 drop. Ticking all the boxes with Lambplan for fast early growth and eating quality. TCP, LEQ, & EQ Indexes and post weaning weight all in the top 5% or above (pwt 22.0) and muscle in the top 10%. Get those suckers off sooner!

NEWBOLD 220134: Newbold 220134 sits in the top 10% for Eating Quality & LEQ indexes. He is in the top 10% for growth and intramuscular fat (meat tenderness) and in the top 5% or above for lambing ease making him a very handy choice with great commercial attributes.

DETPA GROVE 220128: Used by A.I. for the 2024 drop. Detpa Grove 220128 was the top price ram at Detpa's 2024 ram sale where he sold to Valma stud, Tasmania for \$10,000.

WARBURN 200274 Purchased in shares with North Ulandi in 2021. Warburn 274 has been a very reliable sire over the past 4 breeding seasons. He sits in the top 20% for EQ & LEQ indexes and top 20% for LMY & IMF.

WINGAMIN 220317: son of **WINGAMIN 213215 (\$29,000)** Used as a ram lamb. Wingamin 317 sits in the top 10% for weaning weight, top 20% for growth, top 5% for lean meat yield, top 30% for dressing % and eye muscle depth.

LOT 3 & LOT 11's grand dam was Champion & Reserve Champion Shortwool, 2014 Royal Adelaide Show. Dam is triplet sister to stud ram 202686 sold to Millinup Stud, WA for \$8,000.

LOT 5 & LOT 6 were used this joining as ram lambs in the stud.

A minimum of \$3,000 is required to register and transfer stud rams
